**Circular to Dealers in Precious Metals and Stones  
Anti-Money Laundering / Counter-Terrorist Financing**

**United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation (Amendment) Regulation 2026**

The United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation (Amendment) Regulation 2026 (“the Haiti Amendment Regulation”), made under the United Nations Sanctions Ordinance (Cap. 537) (“UNSO”), was published in the Gazette (L.N. 100 of 2026) on 11 September 2026 with immediate effect.

The Haiti Amendment Regulation amends the United Nations Sanctions (Haiti) Regulation to give effect to certain decisions on sanctions under the United Nations Security Council Resolutions 2794 in respect of Haiti. The amendments renew the travel ban, financial sanctions and arms embargo, revise the scope of arms embargo, and reflect the new exemption requirements relating to arms embargo.

Dealers in precious metals and stones are reminded to comply with the regulations made under the UNSO. Category B registrants (“CBRs”) are further reminded to refer to Chapters 6 & 7 of the “Guideline on Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Financing of Terrorism (For Category B Registrants Dealing in Precious Metals and Stones)” which contains guidance on the appropriate measures that CBRs should take to ensure compliance with the relevant requirements.
